# Crest Builder to undertake works for CSCEC worth RM16.28m



RETAINING DATA: Crest Builder Holdings Bhd's subsidiary CBTech (M) Sdn Bhd will undertake mechanical, electrical and plumbing works for China State Construction Engineering Corporation (CSCEC) worth RM16.28mil.

The project will take 23 months for completion, ending on June 11, 2019, and will comprise of all air-conditioning and mechanical ventilation (ACMV) services package works for Angkasapuri Media City in Kuala Lumpur.

With this project, Crest Builder's construction order book stands at about RM1.32bil.

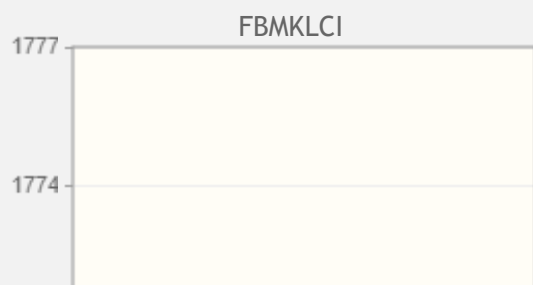
